The school managed to beat a number of Arab schools, some of which are based in Abu Dhabi and Dubai, said Dr Manish Kishor Babbar, head of department for Arabic at JSS Private School. "This is a huge achievement for our school as all the participating students are non-Arab."

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Innovations

In a fast-paced world, it is crucial that we develop and explore technologies across the curriculum. Whether that is through the specialist delivery of Design and Technology or through Computational Thinking, our students are encouraged to think beyond limits. Innovation forms part of the UAE Vision 2021 and as part of the National Agenda, we promote innovation through meaningful learning opportunities with elements of research, exploration, risk taking and critical thinking. The application of skills throughout the curriculum in this way, ensures that our children are ready for the change in the world that is inevitable with new and exciting technologies.

INNOVATION IN TEACHING AND LEARNING:

Experiential Learning:

Students perform various experiments at home with available resources following scientific method, the learning process is enjoyable as it gives concrete experience, observation and active experimentation.

Quads:

The best practices which were visible in pockets across the school was percolated to all the teachers thus strengthening the teaching – learning in the school. Teachers were open to learning and were able to learn new practices from their quad members across the phases and subjects.

Gizmos – online simulation

Students experience and perform experiment online and gather observation from it. A simulation is a form of experiential learning.

VTR – (Visible Thinking Routines): The new concepts start with VTR wherein the teacher displays a picture that can trigger the thought process (that is encouraging active processing which is visible in the class) imagination and questioning skills of the child. This routine helps both the teacher and the learners to discuss together a set of steps or questions that leads to the essential questions or the big question for the lesson.

SOLO Taxonomy: The structure of observed learning outcomes is a model that describes levels of increasing complexity in student's understanding of subjects. This is used to test the prior knowledge (precap) and the outcome (recap). SOLO precap helps to modify the lesson plan for varied learners as per their present level of performance and SOLO recap helps to reflect on their learning and plan for intervention if needed.

STEAM approach: STEAM based lessons are at practice to explore new ways and approaches to help students' practice cross-disciplinary thinking and build skills in science, technology, engineering, and math. It helps them to discover information, examples, and tools related to incorporating aspects of arts, design in school activities. In a steam-based lesson in EVS the teachers use stories and poems to immerse the kids into the new concepts.

Linking literacy with science: Science as a narrative enables the children to explain and interpret their experiences and clarify their own ideas within an authentic and familiar language form. This is evident in the primary phase wherein the children use comprehension passages, scientific writing, comic strips, creating poems where we see the writing and reading enhances the learning of science concepts as well.

VIRTUAL EDUCATIONAL TOURS:

Post Pandemic along with regular field trips, virtual tours will also be used in the lessons. It will be used as lesson motivator or even entire lessons based on virtual tours.

TEACHING STRATEGIES:

- Pose, Pause, Pounce , Bounce - "I have , Who has"
- Strategies to assess student understanding at the end of the lesson: - Out - The - Door - Cards - Exit Ticket
- Quick Write - Visualization, Inference, Text - to - Text , Text- to- self, Text- to-world - Ted Talk
- WOW words - Children are encouraged to use 'WOW' words instead of 'boring' vocabulary to make their writing more vivid and interesting. For example - using 'devastated' instead of 'sad'.
- Virtual vocabulary wall /Dictionary to enhance vocabulary and comprehension skills.
- Scavenger Hunt – Build Problem-Solving Skills Hands-on learning.
- Teacher as writer - teacher attempts any one task along with the students and shares her work and the process she followed
- Didax.com and mnrussbaum.com (Virtual Online manipulative) used for number sense to develop calculation skills and in measurement for shapes.
- POPPLET for collaboration
- Channels / breakout rooms for independent discussions
- Regular use of PADLET, Quizizz, Flip grid
- Live worksheet for intense practice of the concept.
- Interactive White board for introducing concepts.
- Mentimeter, Nearpod, Padlet, Quizizz, MS forms, Class Dojo, Flip grid, classkick, exam.net

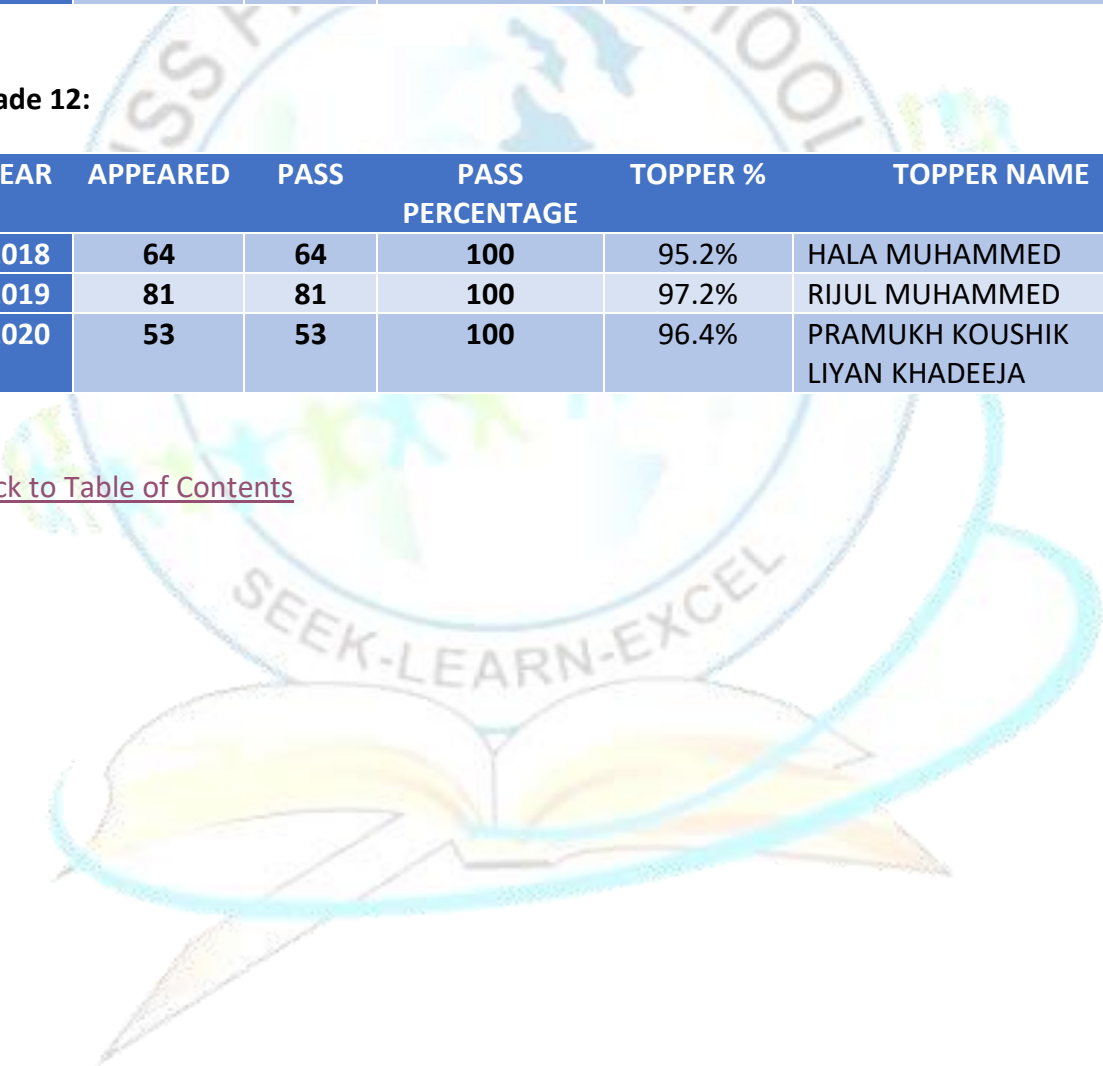
